#### **Notes from Michelle**

Parents - I have made a promise to the teachers that more than 90% of you WILL complete your Parent Input section for the Individual Learning Plan (ILP) form. These forms are used during the discussion at your parent /teacher conference in November. We have included a copy in your Friday Folder, and there will be blank copies available for you outside of the classrooms as you sign up for conferences. These forms may look intimidating, but they are simply a place for you to share with the teacher what you would like to see in each of the areas. If you have questions, bring those questions with you to the conference, but also bring your completed form. We use these meetings to help build a partnership between the parents and the teachers. In upper elementary, the children work towards becoming part of that process also. The Individual Learning Plan is based on the outcomes outlined in our charter as the attributes we hope to see our children acquire at Eagle Peak Montessori. One suggestion might be to bring the form with you to the observation you have scheduled to watch your child in class. You can make notes on the things you observe on the form which can help you to formulate your goals later. By bringing your forms with goals you have for your child, it gives you the opportunity to be an even greater part of your child's educational experience.

The Board of Directors has a very important message below, I encourage you to read it through in its entirety.

## **Board Update**

The Board met on Tuesday, October 18, and had a great meeting. Students from the Adolescent Program came and talked to us about their success so far this year with Friday Market and about a consciousness-raising presentation and volunteer experience with the Contra Costa Food Bank. Each month I am so impressed at the poise and public speaking abilities of our AP students!

Many of you are aware of the movement within the neighborhood around the school to create a new school district that would be separate from Mt. Diablo schools. This group (called Northgate CAPS) in theory would have a right to our property, since all current MDUSD property that currently is geographically within their newly envisioned Northgate School District would become that new district's property. The EPMS Board has been monitoring their activities since they began advocating for this change over a number of years but seemed to be re-energized about a year ago. When this latest reboot of the group appeared, we invited their representatives to speak with the Board and explain what they had in mind. Our lawyer was present at this meeting, so that she could also hear what claims they are making. After talking with their representatives, we decided that their proposed new district is opposed to our mission statement to provide access to Montessori learning to students from a diversity of cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds. Our hope is that they do not succeed in creating their new district.

At our Board Meeting on Tuesday, we discussed them again, noticing that they have proceeded to the stage where they are soliciting signatures to get on the ballot. This is the next step they need to become a new district, though there are still several steps that follow if they do

succeed. We understand that people are justifiably feeling a lot of uncertainty and fear about what might happen to our school if they were to succeed. Would we lose our campus? Would we join the new district? What would happen to our current students who do not live in the Northgate district?

Currently, our plan is to watch, wait, and talk with the Mt. Diablo district about possible contingencies. Even setting aside issues of larger social justice, it would be a substantial risk to our current students if we were to try to join up with a new Northgate district. The individuals who are organizing the Northgate CAPS effort promise that they would continue to allow students from outside the district to attend Eagle Peak, but they can actually make no such promises. If they were to succeed in setting up a new district, it would be up to the new school board and new superintendent to decide what the terms of our charter would be. We would have to rewrite and reapply for our charter with the new district. We can have no guarantee that they would welcome the students to Eagle Peak that they set up a whole new district to try and exclude. The majority of our students do not live in the Northgate neighborhood, and it is our responsibility as a Board to protect and advocate for all of our students and to act as stewards for the mission of our school.

In the upcoming months and years, this may mean that we will face some very difficult decisions. Please know that we are following the situation very closely, and feel empowered in the knowledge that we will always act in the spirit of our mission statement and in the best interests of our students.

If you have any questions about any of the above issues or about what is going on with the school, please come

on by and visit a Board Meeting! They are the third Tuesday of every month at 6:30 and are open to the public. There is a period at the beginning of the meeting reserved for people to tell the Board what is on their mind. The agenda is always posted on the office doors the Friday before the meeting.
