We all know that there are various gadgets and toys that catch the eye of students and they end up popping up at school. The only fidgets, toys, or other such items that should be brought from home are items that the Lower Elementary students bring for sharing. Items such as a pipe cleaners or squeeze balls that the children have discreetly are often very helpful in order for students to keep their focus. However, often times, companies will market a product as educational, which really becomes more of a distraction than a help. Currently there are items called fidget spinners which are being brought to school and causing distraction in the classrooms. These are being treated as toys. We are asking that you do not allow your child to bring them to school. They will not be allowed out in the classroom due to the distraction concern. There are other more appropriate items which are completely acceptable to help your child focus if needed.
