We had a warm, wonderful first week for Lower El in the garden~we observed, smelled, tasted, touched, listened and learned - and enjoyed grapes, Asian pears, playing some games that reinforce our guidelines and build our comfort outside, and listening to stories that stretch our imaginations and widen our listening to stories that stretch our imaginations and widen our lens of the world.

1st years are getting their bearings in the garden and working on guidelines and classification. 2nd and 3rd years will begin botany study next week, 4th and 5th graders will be working on seed units and biodiversity. Our Upper El students will be experiencing several lessons in the garden this year that reinforce their California cultural and historical study focus in the classroom as well as make good use of the Native People's Herb Garden they designed and planted last year. 6th years start mentor training next week,

including a child development lesson to better equip them with skills to guide Lower El students.
