Also, it is very important that you read the rubric that we do use for the various "grades". Most students should only be at a 2 or 3 at this time in the year. If they receive a "1", that would indicate either that the concept was recently introduced, or that they are struggling with that concept. It is important to read the narrative sections to learn which case it is. As always, please feel free to email your child's teacher with any questions on clarification.
