### **Notes from Michelle**

Tuesday night we held our first prospective parent meeting for the year. The process of meeting all the people who hope to join the Eagle Peak community is always exciting and interesting. So many people speak so highly of the reputation that Eagle Peak has, not just academically, but in all areas. We all work very hard at creating and maintaining (including parents and community) that culture at Eagle Peak. Thank you for your part.

As in the paragraph above, we talk often of the high expectations we have for the students at Eagle Peak. We recognize that adult behavior is the model for the students. We need to ask for your help in these matters from time to time.

The Adolescent Students have brought some concerns to me regarding Friday Market protocol and I agree: these are some things we need to ask you- the parents- to help us with on campus. First, they have noticed that sometimes, there are adults who are reaching over younger students in order to reach items for their children who are further back in the line. Please recognize that the children who are in line may also want those objects and it is not fair for adults to reach over children waiting patiently for them. There also seem to be adults waiting in their cars in the carpool lane for children going to Friday Market. This is not the proper protocol. If you want your child to visit the Friday Market, you need to park,

walk in, and accompany them to the line. We do not allow children who are not with parents to visit the Friday Market, unless they are children staying for childcare. In the case of childcare students, they are accompanied by the child care workers. We thank you in advance for modeling the Eagle Peak virtue of respect and what we often refer to in the Montessori training as "grace and courtesy".

One other concern that was brought to me by the teachers is a new practice of older siblings who do not currently attend Eagle Peak returning for birthday celebrations. While we understand that children who are currently at Eagle Peak attending their siblings celebration, we need to ask that if older siblings do return to campus for celebrations, that they do not bring non- alumni friends with them and that they observe the campus no electronics policy while on campus. This would not be the case after school or when classes are not in session. We also need to request that alumni students do not return for non-sibling birthday celebrations on campus. These celebrations are simply in-class acknowledgements, and not the same type of social event as a party. We appreciate your support in these matters as well.

While it may seem as though we have been in school a long time, is has really only been 5 weeks. We know you are eager to know how your child is doing in the classroom, but we strongly encourage you to wait until the parent conferences for that conversation. These take place at the beginning of November. Thank you for your patience.
