Music Notes from Ms. Allison

Hold the date for Parent Education Night on January 13th at 7 pm. I will be presenting details about early childhood music education, Montessori's methods and Orff Schulwerk philosophies and more importantly demonstrating some of the activities that your child does during music classes at Eagle Peak. This event is for parents only.



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Music Notes from Ms. Allison (con't)

Last Friday Folder, I provided a pledge form for the Upper El students and the parents to sign. If you missed my notes, please go back and read them, they are guite important to the success and happiness of your child in music classes. Although they are not due until Dec 9th, I have received many completed pledges and thus, your student may have brought home their recorder this week. Please set limits on where and when for your household harmony: not in the car (or fingering only in the car), in a room with door closed, not while a sibling is sleeping, etc. Remind them of the backpack rule and gentle blowing technique using only the breath that causes the candle flame to flicker. Students are not required to bring them home, however, the more they play, the more confident they become and the sooner we can do more complicated pieces. You can also simply buy them one for home (The Dollar Store has some that are just fine for home practice.)

This Wednesday, almost all 4th years were able to cut a cleaning cloth from extra material that Morgan W. brought to share. THANK YOU!!! They are encouraged to ask you for cotton material to make as many as they need/want - nothing fancy... approximately an 8" x 2" rectangle. "How do you do today?" was our large movement piece where we had to shift our voices into contrasting styles (loud/soft, high/low, fast, slow) and we had to shift our bodies trading places with a different partner each time. We also started a new piece, En Ten Tina, (a nonsense syllable song) and added a new note (C) to their known tone set of BAG and D. Accompaniment instrument parts added drone notes, rhythmic pulses and color timbres. Some students added dance as well. I added a recorder countermelody when possible.

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Music Notes from Ms. Allison (con't)

Lower El class activities were as reported in the last notes. 6th graders worked on fluency with C, F, and G chords on the ukulele as well as learning the C scale using three of the four strings and fingering the patterns of whole steps and half steps on the fret board. We also started using a felt pick. Happy fingers!


