<u>Music Notes (con't)</u>

Three weeks ago, I had a show-and-tell lesson for the 4th and 5th years where I brought in my medieval harp and an autoharp. We discussed sound production, tuning, black and red strings denoting C's and F's, plucking/pressing vs strumming strings, different picks, chordal accompaniment, how pads were shaped to dampen strings on the autoharp when depressing the button to make a specific chord, and much more. I sang a medieval Italian lauda (praise song) and accompanied myself on the harp. Then we passed around the autoharp and took turns accompanying many verses and choruses of Cumberland Gap, Yankee Doodle, and 'Tis A Gift To Be Simple.

The following week, I invited them to bring their musical talent into class and we were treated to some wonderful a cappella singing, violin and piano playing. It was a great way to practice our "4 A's of Good Audience Behavior: Attend, Allow, Applaud, & Appreciate."

This week both lower el group B and 4th &5th years took part in a Creative Movement class which focuses on finding shapes that are straight/angled vs curved/round with different parts of our body individually and in groups. We then applied decisions to transitioning from one memorized shape to another based on tempo, duration, direction: indirect vs direct, direction of movement, strong or delicate force, sustained or sudden effort, and many more options that make up the basic elements of dance. When we added different styles of recorded music to the groups' sharing, many times it shifted their choices as they responded to the music. 
